## SAFETY & QUALITY INDICATORS

We collect a range of indicators to monitor our care delivery and benchmark these results with other hospitals to help us measure how we are performing. Here are some of our results from 2022.

### CHANGES TO THE NATIONAL STANDARDS ACCREDITATION PROCESS

Mandatory short notice assessments to the National Safety and Quality Health Service (NSQHS) Standards will commence from July 2023 for all public and private health facilities with only one business days' notice. It is likely that our assessment will occur here between July and December this year as our accreditation expires in March 2024.

#### **HAND HYGIENE**

Hand Hygiene is the most effective method of preventing the spread of infection. Clinical staff are observed to monitor their compliance with hand hygiene requirements. Our results are submitted to Hand Hygiene Australia (HHA) and compared to the National Benchmark rate.

## INFECTION PREVENTION & CONTROL MANAGEMENT REVIEW RESULTS

We conduct regular audits to monitor compliance with the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards for Infection Prevention and Control. Our recent audit conducted in March this year showed 96% compliance achieved. There have been several new criteria added this year as a result of increased requirements due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
