#### **PATIENT & CARER SATISFACTION SURVEY RESULTS**

Wolper Jewish Hospital belongs to the Private Hospital Benchmarking Group (PHBG) which has 12 members. Each year we complete a Patient Satisfaction Survey and benchmark our results. This survey was completed by 57 patients in April 2023. The overall satisfaction rate was 96% a 3% increase since last year. Here are the results:

#### **RISK MANAGEMENT**

Wolper takes a proactive approach to Risk Management. The **Risk Register** is continuously updated with Clinical Risks reviewed by the Clinical Care committee and Non-Clinical Risks reviewed by the Quality & Risk Committee. Risks are reported to the Medical Advisory Committee (MAC) and the Wolper Board via the Quarterly Safety and Quality Report. Staff education follows a comprehensive Education Calendar and includes mandatory Elearning modules and practical inservices each month as well as specific competencies training for applicable staff and departments.

Education and appraisal rates are reviewed and monitored by the Quality & Risk Committee. Clinical indicators including complaints are reviewed at the Consumer Focus **Group** meetings twice per year and with the Private Hospital Benchmarking Group each quarter. Staff vaccination rates are monitored and reviewed at the Clinical Care Meetings.

### **ANTIMICROBIAL STEWARDSHIP**

Wolper monitors antimicrobial usage and appropriateness of prescribing and reports the results to the Wolper MAC and the Wolper Board of Directors. Between May and July 2023. 40 patients were audited for antimicrobial usage by the clinical pharmacist.

The overall result was 56% compliance. Results included - No adverse reactions to antimicrobials 100%, Restricted antimicrobials not used 100%, Microbiology supported the prescription 67.5%, Duration of treatment of antibiotic written on Medication Chart 60%, Duration of administration complies with Therapeutic guidelines 52.5% and Prophylactic Antibiotics discontinued after surgery 33%. The results were discussed by the Medical Advisory Committee.
